Resumption of the Circuit of Embassies

Last month, the EAI resumed negotiations with the Circuit of Embassies Program. A partnership with other secretariats of the Federal District, the program aims to promote cultural exchange with demonstrations of the history, architecture and gastronomy of the countries represented here. The aim is to promote a free public event, opening embassies to community visitation.

NEW ERA OF TECHNOLOGY IN EDUCATION

The month of September is marked by the International Literacy Day, celebrated on the 8th. As a fundamental process in all educational systems around the world, literacy is the driving force for the development of more just, cohesive and egalitarian societies. Through literacy, individuals build their reading and writing skills, expanding their horizons.

The COVID-19 pandemic and the measures put in place by local governments, in favor of public health, made it difficult and affected learning around the world with the closing of schools and universities. Since education is a universal right to be promoted and encouraged - as provided for in the Sustainable Development Goals of the 2030 Agenda, teachers and professionals in the area needed to reinvent themselves to overcome the challenges imposed, identifying and positioning, in this reality, technology as an enabling alternative for access to education.

Digital tools were fundamental to the maintenance of teaching activities during the pandemic and transformed the traditional method of teaching at a global level. Remote learning shortened distances, optimized time and resources, and was able to transform schools and universities into centers of innovation.

During the period of social restrictions imposed by the pandemic, the GDF ensured the continuity of education, through technology, with the "Escola em Casa DF" Program and its transmissions of educational content on television.

The success of Information and Communication Technologies (ICTs) demonstrated the importance of integrating technology and education, not only in emergency situations, but to advance, more and more, in relation to the way in which we promote knowledge.

150 "Streets for Schools" are implemented in Paris to promote safety for children

"Streets for schools" consists of total or partial pedestrianization around kindergartens and primary schools. The concept means giving pedestrians access to the streets back. The idea is to make the way home-school safer for children, while fighting pollution, eliminating the passage of motor vehicles whenever its possible.

Startup in School will be held for public school students

With the aim of awake and develop the entrepreneurial skills of students from the public education network in the Federal District, the first regional version of Startup In School (SiS) will be held. In this project, students from the 9th grade of elementary school to the 3rd year of high school will be able to participate, who will be encouraged to create a startup that improves the daily life of the place where they live. The program is promoted by Google Startup in School DF, a partnership between the consulting firm 'Ideias de Futuro', creator of the proposal, Google, sponsor since 2015, and the Federal District Education Department.

Government implements sign language courses for elementary and high school students

The Government of Chile is carrying out a pilot project, developed by the National Service for People with Disabilities (Senadis) in partnership with the En Señas Foundation, to implement sign language courses for elementary and high school students. The initiative seeks to promote the learning of Chilean sign language and deaf culture in hearing students, who mostly share classrooms with deaf students, to facilitate their communication and generate an impact on school life.

UNESCO and UNODC launch publication on strengthening the rule of law through education

On September 30, the event "Strengthening the rule of law through education: from theory to practice", held by UNESCO and UNODC, celebrated the launch of the Portuguese version of the publication "Empowering students for just societies: a guide for teachers of primary education". The guests shared perspectives on the importance of building bridges between the Justice and Education sectors, as well as the relationship between Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) 4 and 16 as conduits for peaceful, fair and strong societies.
