Viver Brasília: an international perspective

Ten ambassadors residing in Brasília participated in the project "*Viver Brasília: an international perspective*", a partnership between the EAI and SECEC - Secretariat of Culture and Creative Economy of the Federal District. The route included five historical and cultural points based on the book "*Roteiro Geopoético de Brasília*", by journalist Amneres Santiago, who was also the group's guide. GDF honors firefighters returning from Haiti

Twenty-four members of the Federal District Military Fire Department (CBMDF), four members of the Minas Gerais Fire Department (CBMG) and four members of the National Force were honored on October 5 at the Palácio do Buriti for integrating the task force team that went to Haiti on a humanitarian mission after the climatic events that hit the country.

CARE FOR CHILDHOOD: A GLOBAL DUTY

Playing catch, hide-and-seek, crafting stories with dolls and images with brushes: examples of essential tools for the healthy development of individuals.

The 1989 Convention on the Rights of the Child is supported by new scientific evidence on human development, through which the child is considered a social subject of rights, with the ability to think, interrelate, choose between options and interact with the environment. Researches point out the importance of playfulness in the first years of life, from physical growth and language acquisition to the creation of social and cultural bases that will support adulthood. Playing is an intercultural and multidisciplinary practice, which bears even more relevance in its stimulation since the first months of life.

Based on this understanding, the GDF undertakes efforts, along with civil society, to promote the exercise of children's right to fully enjoy playing games, in compliance with the Principle VII of the Universal Declaration of Children's Rights, of 1959.

Last October, to commemorate Children's Day, the GDF promoted the "*Vem Brincar Comigo*" (Come Play with Me, in English) campaign, aimed at children in situations of social vulnerability, which collected and distributed children's toys and books. An extension of this campaign, the "*Adote um Espaço Criança*" (Adopt a Child Space, in English) initiative mobilized the diplomatic community of Brasília to set up recreational spaces in Health Units and Social Care Centers.

In recent years, the world has witnessed important political decisions on the protection, care and education of children in early childhood, demonstrating the need to understand the care of children as a duty not only of the family, but of the State and the whole society.

Only a holistic look at social responsibility in guaranteeing children's rights is able to catalyze the effectiveness of the rights of those who are, today, the little heirs of our legacy.

Statute guarantees rights and duties of young people

A law sanctioned by the governor encourages the creation of public policies and projects, relying on the popular participation. The norm establishes the right to several areas, such as work, education, health, mobility, culture, recreation and social reintegration. With regard to duties, the measure establishes that every young person must respect the defense of peace, political and religious pluralism, the dignity of the human person and the tolerance of diversity.

Movie series on children's rights promotes a healthy and sustainable life

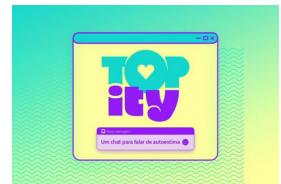

New project aims to consolidate the initiative to eradicate child labor in Latin America and the Caribbean

The Brazilian Cooperation Agency (ABC), of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MRE), in partnership with the International Labor Organization (ILO) and other Brazilian institutions, launched the Project "Consolidation of the progress of the Regional Initiative in Latin America and the Caribbean Free of Child Labor", which aims to combat child labor in the region until 2023. The Regional Initiative is an intergovernmental and tripartite platform, made up of more than 30 countries, and aims to declare Latin America and the Caribbean as the first region in development child labor-free by 2025.
