International Opportunities

In partnership with the city of Cordoba | Argentina, the EAI submitted the project "Internationalization & Colored Economies: strategies towards Local Economic Development in metropolitan areas" to the Metropolis network's 3rd Call for Pilot Projects.

Partnerships with SLU-DF, SEPE-DF, SEMA-DF and SEE-DF yielded applications for three government initiatives ("Integrated and Sustainable Management Program for Solid Waste in DF", "Paranoa Lake Shore Recovery Project" and "Social Factory Program") to the Guangzhou Award for Urban Innovation.
