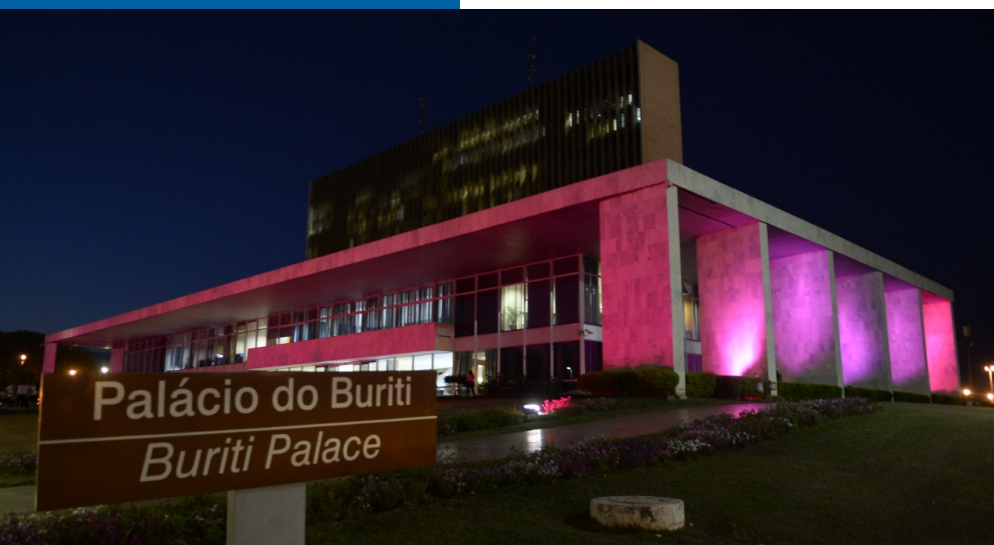

Accessory Bank and Pink Lighting Campaigns

From October 21st to November the 6th, the Office of International Affairs (EAI), the Secretariat of Women and the Executive Secretariat of Valorization and Quality of Life (Sequali) - tied to the Secretariat of Economy - promoted the Accessory Bank Campaign, created to collect caps, hats, headscarves and other props that will be delivered to the Base Hospital of Brasília and passed on to cancer patients.

PPEs: from China to Brasília

The Federal District [received a batch of donations](#), worth 2.5 million reais, in personal protective equipments (PPEs) from China, through its Embassy in Brasilia.

The GDF thanked the donations and the partnership between the Federal District and China in a virtual ceremony with the Chinese Ambassador, Yang Wanming, the Vice-Governor Paco Britto, representing Governor Ibaneis Rocha and representatives of SES-DF and EAI.
