EAI HIGHLIGHTS

Cities Networks

Brasília was present at the Metropolis General Assembly and at the XXV Mercocities Summit, during which the main lines of action for 2021 were defined and the directive bodies of the networks were renewed. The city was also represented at the XXXV Meeting of the Culture Committee of the Union of Ibero-American Capital Cities (UCCI), an opportunity for the EAI and the Secretariat for Culture and Creative Economy (SECEC) to explain the mechanisms for promoting and democratizing culture in the new pandemic context in the Federal District.

HUMAN RIGHTS

On December 10, 1948, the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR) was adopted by the United Nations presenting the basic rights to which all human beings should have access. Ever since, the date has been celebrated as the International Human Rights Day.

In 2020, when the whole world turned its attention and strengths to fight the COVID-19 pandemic, the Declaration's 72nd anniversary was celebrated, in a moment when several countries started immunization plans against this disease that will mark the century.

The Declaration recognizes, in its 25th article, health as an inalienable right of each and every person and as a social value to be pursued by the humanity. In the search for the preservation and promotion of this right, cooperation between countries and international organizations for the sharing of good practices in the fight against the virus, as well as the exchange of knowledge and technology, were extremely important factors in the production of an effective and secure vaccine in record time.

At the time vaccines are made available, health as a universal right for all is made evident as the result of cooperative efforts by governments, universities and the private sector so that the immunizing agent reaches all nations across the globe.
